


Page Jumps (also known as 'anchors') are quick links to content on the current page.

## Edit Page to add a jump destination

Go into 'Text' mode and add a destination id to the element to jump to. This would normally be inside a tag such as a heading. Just add something like `'id="mydestination"'`



## Edit Page to add jump source

Swap back to 'visual' mode. Highlight the text to link from and click the 'add link' button
